

CLUB RULES

- ❖ Each and every member has a responsibility towards the best interests of Tullow & South Leinster Tennis & Sports Club to ensure its long term success and survival. Please treat the club as you would your own property and take responsibility to ensure its continued success.
- Members should behave with the utmost courtesy at all times and consideration should be given towards other members, particularly those playing on court.
- Access to Club Members and those who have paid green fees only. No bystanders allowed. Please see Rates page for information on our membership fees and green fees.
- Play is limited to 1 hour.
- If all courts are being used and there is a queue to play then singles must double up.
- Appropriate tennis attire and footwear should be worn on court at all times.
- Tennis shoes should be cleaned before entering courts. Please remove grit/small stones/gravel, as this will damage the courts.
- No fizzy drinks or alcohol are permitted in or around the courts.
- No Food/Chewing gum allowed on courts.
- Smoking is forbidden.
- Leaving litter in the court area or on the club grounds is strictly forbidden.
- The club premises must be kept clean. In the event of a match or tournament it is the responsibility of the organising person(s) to ensure that the premises are left in a clean and proper state. All club members must bring their own rubbish home.
- Children are not permitted on the courts after 7:00 pm.
- All children must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- No dogs allowed on courts or on club property.
- The club accepts no responsibility for any items lost or stolen on club premises. It is the responsibility of each individual to take care of his/her property.
- No other ball games except for tennis allowed on courts.
- Bad language will not be tolerated.
- Verbal abuse of any members/club committee may result in immediate expulsion from the club.
- Any abuse of club property should be reported to the committee immediately.
- Any breach of club rules will be dealt with by the committee.
- The committee reserves the right of admission to the club's grounds and/or premises.
- The decision of the committee is final.
